Scenarios for Problem Solving

A student pulls you aside at CCD. She asks if she can talk to you about something important. She suggests that the matter is urgent and “personal.” What can you do to respond to her needs and respect her privacy, while insuring a safe environment for her and your other students?

You and your spouse are supervising a group of 10 youth during a trip to the Denver area. As you are hiking to the Mother Cabrini Shrine for morning Mass one of the young men in your group injures his ankle and can't continue. How can you respond to his needs while providing a safe environment for him and the rest of the youth in your group?

You team-teach the second grade class with another teacher. You are scheduled to meet with your class for a special session to prepare them for First Communion. On your way to the class one of your own children throws up in the car. What can you do to meet your own child's needs while providing a safe environment for your students?

You are the associate pastor of a parish of 400 families. Following the final Mass on Sunday morning a young boy of 11 years old comes to the rectory. He states that he would like to visit with you about a problem with his parents. What would you do?
