

Instructions for Completing  
“What do you remember about Adult / Child Interactions?”  
Coloring sheet with 3-8 Grade Students

Prior to beginning discussion during the “Know the Rules for Adult / Child Interactions” session:

- Distribute “What do you remember?” coloring sheet to students.
- Ask them to fill in the blanks with any of the rules they remember from previous years in class.
- Gather “What do you remember?” coloring sheets.

Continue with “Know the Rules for Adult / Child Interactions” session.

- You may wish to review answers to “What do you remember?” as an optional activity during the lesson.

Following session:

- Attach “What do you remember?” coloring sheets together.
- Label with grade level, parish / school / program, date of session, and number of students in attendance.
- Include any opt out / refusal sheets, if applicable.

- Review answers to “Rules and Reasons” as part of discussion / activity during the lesson.

Following session:

- Attach “Rules and Reasons” sheets together.
- Label with grade level, parish / school / program, date of session, and number of students in attendance.
- Include any opt out / refusal sheets, if applicable.
