

The Diocesan Review Board – Is a panel including the Chancellor and eight other persons of whom a minimum of four are practicing Catholics. This panel serves as the consultative body to the Bishop regarding the implementation and application of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, review of particular allegations or cases, review of Diocesan policies, practices and procedures for the creation of safe environments, proactive protection of minors and prevention of the abuse of minors by personnel of the Diocese. (Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, Article 2; Essential Norms, Article 5).
